


# LETTER FROM THE RABI

How Do I Love Me? Let Me Count the Days

My title is not really a riff on Elizabeth Barrett Browning's Sonnets from the Portuguese (Sonnet 43's first line), "How do I love thee? Let me count the ways." Rather, my rewrite suggests that love can become manifest by taking proactive steps to express that love, whether it be love for a beloved Other or for one's self. Between Passover (when we are physically freed from slavery but still carry our slave mentality) and Shavuot (when tradition teaches that neither Pharaoh's physical nor spiritual fetters hold us back and we can freely express our love for God through the Mitzvot), we are on a journey, a fifty-day journey to spiritual freedom. Fifty steps.

All of us carry our spiritual Mitzrayim—our Egypts—i.e. our bad habits and dysfunctions that have been generated over our lifetimes. The patterns that prevent us from being self-actualized. The baggage we carry in relationships that can prevent us from fulfilling our higher callings, what the mystics call k'lipot, the shards that are scattered, disorganized, chaotic. Without addressing these limits, our lives flounder. We might feel utterly alone, despite the blessings of family and friends, because we are acting in a suboptimal fashion due to ancient pains that hold us back and undermine our clarity. And as a result, we lose our confidence, we fall out of love with ourselves.

### Enter Judaism.

Among the most powerful of Jewish spiritual tools (and perhaps least appreciated), the daily Counting the Omer demands that we rattle our imperfections and reflect, grow, imagine ourselves improving our lot and

breaking the patterns that don't serve us. Thus, well before 12-step programs came this fifty-step Jewish creation! Each day between Passover and Shavuot—which includes the entirety of this month of May—offers an opportunity to reflect on how to make ourselves better. That is, by counting the days (with the intention of fixing that which is broken within us), we demonstrate self-love, rewarding ourselves with greater happiness and confidence. So "How do I love thee? Let me count the ways" means, "How do I show love? By (ac-)counting 49 days of spiritual growth and focus on making myself a better person:



### בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יִי אֱ-לֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אשׁר קדּשׁנוּ בּמצוֹתיו, וצוּנוּ על ספירת העֹמר.

Baruch Ata A-donai, E-loheinu Melech Ha'olam, Asher kidshanu b'mitzvotav, v'tzivanu al sfirat ha'omer

Blessed are You, A-donai our God, Ruler of the Universe, Who Sanctified us with Commandments, and Commands us regarding Counting the Omer

The mystics add this spiritual kavvanah (spiritual intention) to their count:

May it therefore be your will, A-donai our God and God of our ancestors, that through the merit of counting the Omer which I have counted today, that which was damaged (in the S'firah of \_\_\_\_\_\_) will be fixed;

I will be purified and made holy with the holiness of Above,
And through this, abundant flow will be poured into all the worlds,
To fix our lives, spirits, and souls, of all dross and damage,
to purify and make us holy with Your Supernal Holiness. Amen, Selah!

That is, our counting fixes that which is broken, in us and in the world. So.... How do I love Thee (both you, me, and God)? Let me count the ways/days! May this year's count bring you closer to self-actualization and bring a Tikkun (fixing) of everything that is broken in your life and in the world around us.

# LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Shalom Friends who are my family,

Our world feels on fire! The hostages are not freed yet. The war in Gaza is raging. The protests on college campuses in the name of pro-Palestinians are causing mayhem and normalizing antisemitic rhetoric. I have read extremely mean-spirited words aimed at our fellow Jews on Facebook. Our own city council members have been threatened with murder in the name of the Palestinian cause. Yom HaShoah, Holocaust Remembrance Day, commences May 5th this year. We will commemorate it by showing <u>Enemies</u>, a <u>Love Story</u> on Sunday May 5th in the social hall. It will be our movie night instead of the second Saturday of the month that falls on Mother's Day weekend in May.

One of our congregants donated memorial candles to each of our families. These will be delivered to you in time to participate in the sacred act of remembering our fellow Jews who perished in the hands of evil. The mother of Hersh Goldberg Polin, who is held captive in Gaza and has lost his left hand in the attack, says: Hope is Mandatory! May we continue to stand united, strong and resolved as we experience our Jewishness with all the blessings and challenges.

June 2nd will be our annual congregational meeting. We will have our second annual picnic at noon followed by the formal meeting starting at 1:30. I am looking forward to breaking bread with you in person and conducting our Temple's business.


